Dear Valued Clients,

OLI Systems, Inc. is announcing the end of sales for ScaleChem Standard, effective January 4, 2017. Maintenance support for existing ScaleChem Standard installations will be available until December 31, 2017.

We appreciate and support the diversity of applications in our client base, and our strategy has been to support all products in our current product slate. However, ScaleChem Standard is now twenty-year old software. Its architecture and application are dated, and its features and functions do not effectively meet the increasingly technical needs of upstream users. Most importantly it does not support our newest mixed solvent electrolyte (MSE) thermodynamic framework.

OLI strategy going forward is to develop advanced upstream applications and thermodynamics in OLI Studio: ScaleChem. OLI Studio: ScaleChem has a modern and connected interface and has access to both AQ and MSE thermodynamic frameworks. These improvements increase application purview, speed up case generation, and make it easier to interpret results; all of which increases productivity.

By **January 3, 2017**, OLI will:

- Offer all current clients the upgrade to OLI Studio: ScaleChem
- Offer all clients help on converting any ScaleChem Standard work to OLI Studio: ScaleChem

OLI will honor any existing lease of ScaleChem Standard or any maintenance, upgrade and support contract for ScaleChem Standard that is already in effect, through the end of the client's current lease term.

OLI will also allow short-term (1-year) renewals of the ScaleChem Standard program for clients who prefer to stay with this program, through December 2017.

OLI will also give any OLI Studio: ScaleChem client access to the ScaleChem Standard software for the remainder of 2017.

Beginning **January 2, 2018**, OLI will give access to ScaleChem Standard copies on an exception basis only.
